VACCINATION FOR DOGS

Dogs must be vaccinated against these diseases:

- 1) *Distemper,*
- 2) *Hepatitis,*
- 3) *Para influenza,*
- 4) *Parvovirus,*
- 5) *Leptospirosis*
- 6) *Rabies*

- All of these are **killer diseases**, all of them exist in Saudi Arabia.
- Rabies is a threat to humans, being an zoonotic disease.
- Puppies should be vaccinated at 2 months of age, with a follow up vaccination at 3 months. In specific cases an extra vaccination against Parvovirus can be given to young puppies of 6 weeks old.
- To maintain immunity an annual booster vaccination must be given.
